Conditions of Approval to Flare Gas

1. Approval not to exceed 365 days from date of submission.
2. All flaring under this request is considered “avoidably lost”. Volumes for avoidably lost gas shall be reported on OGOR “B” reports as disposition code “33”.

Exceptions:

- a. The first 24 hours of a temporary emergency flare is royalty free (NTL-4A III.A). Emergency flared volumes are not to be included in a Sundry Notice (Form 3160-5). These Volumes are not royalty bearing and shall be reported on OGOR “B” as either disposition code “21” or “22”.
- b. If the operator believes that the flared volumes were an emergency under NTL-4A III.A and the flaring exceeded 24 hours, the operator can submit a request via Sundry Notice (Form 3160-5) with justification for an exception.
